Antonio Zampolli (1937–2003)

Computational Linguistics started in Italy with Antonio Zampolli. He had the first (for many years the only one) chair of Computational Linguistics, and he founded the Istituto di Linguistica Computazionale of the CNR in Pisa, of which he has always been the director. He has dedicated all his life to it, and we have now asked that the Institute is entitled to his name. In the early '70s he organised the famous Pisa Summer Schools, at a time when summer schools were not trendy as they are now, gathering in Pisa the best names of the time. He always remembered that Joan Bresnan and Ron Kaplan gave birth to lexical functional grammar on a tower in San Gimignano. These schools have formed a whole generation of computational linguists, lexicographers, etc. all over Europe, and are still remembered as big events by many.

He was a man of great visions, as few are, capable of anticipating and creating the future, always pushing towards new directions and new initiatives, often struggling to make his intuitions become a reality. He also had the great capability of mixing people coming from different communities, thus creating the perfect mixtures to develop new ideas. He was able to communicate to everyone his enthusiasm and his passion. He was the designer and coordinator of such a big quantity of national, European, and international projects. He has founded so many associations, boards, committees, networks (ELSNET and ELRA just to mention two of them), and was president of almost everything. Among others, he was one of the founders of EURALEX and was later on its President, again understanding the importance of mixing traditional and computational lexicography.

He has ‘invented’ the field of Language Resources, at a time when it was almost a shame to speak about data. But he believed in it and pushed for it. The beginning of this era was the famous Grosseto Workshop in 1985. Now everyone speaks about language resources, as if it were normal, but someone had to struggle to open this direction of work. He created a long series of standardisation initiatives, from TEI to EAGLES, and innumerable projects to set up a European and world-wide infrastructure of language resources, culminating with the setting up of a European Network of National projects (ENABLER) and the founding of the International Committee for Written Language Resources, with representatives from all the continents. He invented LREC, such a successful conference, where once again there is a real gathering of so many different communities.

He was a guide and a maestro for so many of us, a ‘living legend’ as has been said. But also, in a unique combination, a man who was loved for his humour, his sympathy, his enthusiasm, his vitality, his intuitions, his friendliness to all, his wonderful stories.

Antonio Zampolli is no longer with us, but he will continue to live with all of us who loved him and who continue to work in one of the many directions that he opened.

2004 Laurence Urdang Award

Applications are invited for the Laurence Urdang Award (formerly the Verbatim Award), which is funded by Laurence Urdang and administered by EURALEX. Its purpose is to support unpaid lexicographical work of any type, including study. The amount available is GBP £1500 sterling, and an individual award may vary in size from GBP £250 to the full amount. Applications must be received by **30 September 2004**. Results will be announced by early 2005, and awards will be presented as soon as possible after the notification of results.

Applications should take the form of:

1. a letter specifying the amount applied for;
2. a statement giving full details of the purpose to which the funds would be put, and an indication of expected tangible results (e.g. publications);
3. a curriculum vitae including qualifications, details of previous lexicographical or related work, and publications;
4. one professional or academic reference;
5. details of funding received or applied for in relation to the project for which the Laurence Urdang Award is being sought.
